Annual Budget Meeting

On Tuesday, December 8th at 7pm, the Board conducted their annual budget meeting via Zoom. It was a very successful meeting as we discussed the many things we have been able to accomplish within this past year. Here is a summary of the meeting:

- The Board unanimously approved the Preservation of Covenants of Documents for our community. This means we renewed the recorded documents that keeps our homeowners association in place for another 30 years.
- We clarified a typo in the proposed 2021 budget that stated maintenance fees are paid monthly. They are not. The approved 2021 budget shows that our maintenance fees will remain the same at \$39.00 and paid quarterly.
- Due to COVID, and from legal counsel, the annual elections of the HOA Board will be postponed. We are currently looking into a safe, yet legal, way of holding the elections to ensure everyone's health and safety.
- One goal for next year is to continue improving the community by repairing damaged sidewalks and getting bids to repave of the roads. These are large and potentially costly projects, so we are looking at many bids to get the best prices.

We would also like to take the opportunity to acknowledge how beautiful the neighborhood is looking with all of the beautiful holiday decorations put up by homeowners this year. We hope to resume the holiday decorating contest next year.
