Fireworks, picnics and other Fourth of July traditions can be great fun for people; but all of the festivities can be frightening and even dangerous for animals. Noisy fireworks and other celebrations can startle animals and cause them to run away; holiday foods can be unhealthy; summer heat and travel can be dangerous; and potentially dangerous debris can end up lying on the ground where pets can eat or play with it.

Whether or not you're planning your own Independence Day celebration, it's important to take precautions to keep your pets safe both during and after Fourth of July festivities. Make sure your pets – cats and dogs alike – have identification tags with up-to-date information. If your pets aren't already microchipped, talk with your veterinarian about microchipping. This simple procedure can greatly improve your chances of getting your pets back if they become lost.

After 4th of July celebrations, check your yard for fireworks debris before allowing pets outside to play or relax. Even if you didn't set off fireworks yourself, debris can make its way into your yard, where curious animals may pick it up to play with or eat. We hope you all have a fun and safe 4th of July!

TROPICAL STORM ELSA

Tropical Storm Elsa is the earliest fifth named storm on record. Right now, it is moving at a fast pace to the West at 25 mph and forecast to pass through portions of the Windward Islands on Friday and emerge into the Caribbean late Friday. Then, it will move near or South of Hispaniola on Saturday.
The forecast beyond Saturday becomes highly uncertain as computer models are giving different solutions on the outcome. One of the most reliable models is the European and it has Elsa turning northward after interacting with the Dominican Republic and Haiti. While the Global (also reliable) and several other ones take Elsa across Western Cuba and into the Southeast Gulf of Mexico.

If the Global model is right, we would see more impacts (rain & gusty winds) across South Florida starting late Monday into Tuesday. For now, Florida should monitor the latest updates, but it is too soon to determine what if any impacts could occur next week given the uncertainty in the long-range forecast.
